DIRECTIONS:

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Hook-and-loop fastener dots, scissors, "before" page, "after" page, cut out family members

SET-UP:

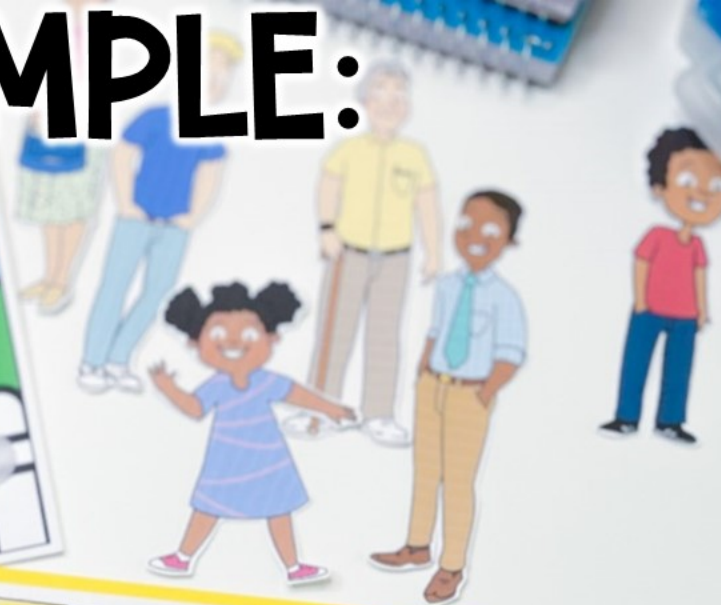
A sample is provided on the next page. Please print the "before" and "after" pages, as well as the 2 pages of family members. Next, please cut out each of the family members (it's easier and quicker to cut out a rectangle around each person!). You may choose to laminate the materials and/or use cardstock for sturdiness/durability. Next, to make the activity reusable and interactive, please place 6 hook-and-loop fastener dots (soft side) along the fence on the "before" page. Then, please place 4 hook-and-loop fastener dots (soft side) along the bottom of the page on the grey house side on the "after" page, and along the bottom of the page on the green house side on the "after" page. Next, please place a hook-and-loop fastener dot (rough side) on the back of each family member.

TO USE:

This activity can be done with individual or small groups of students to help them understand and process how their life has changed since their parents' separation or divorce. Students choose a family member cut-out to represent themselves and each member of their family. Then, they place each family member on the hook-and-loop fastener dots to show who lived in their house "before" the changes. Next, they place them on the two separate houses to show their life "after" the changes. Students can move the same characters from house to house, or the educator may choose to print two sets of each clipart person in case the child wants to look at both pages at the same time using the same cut-out people.

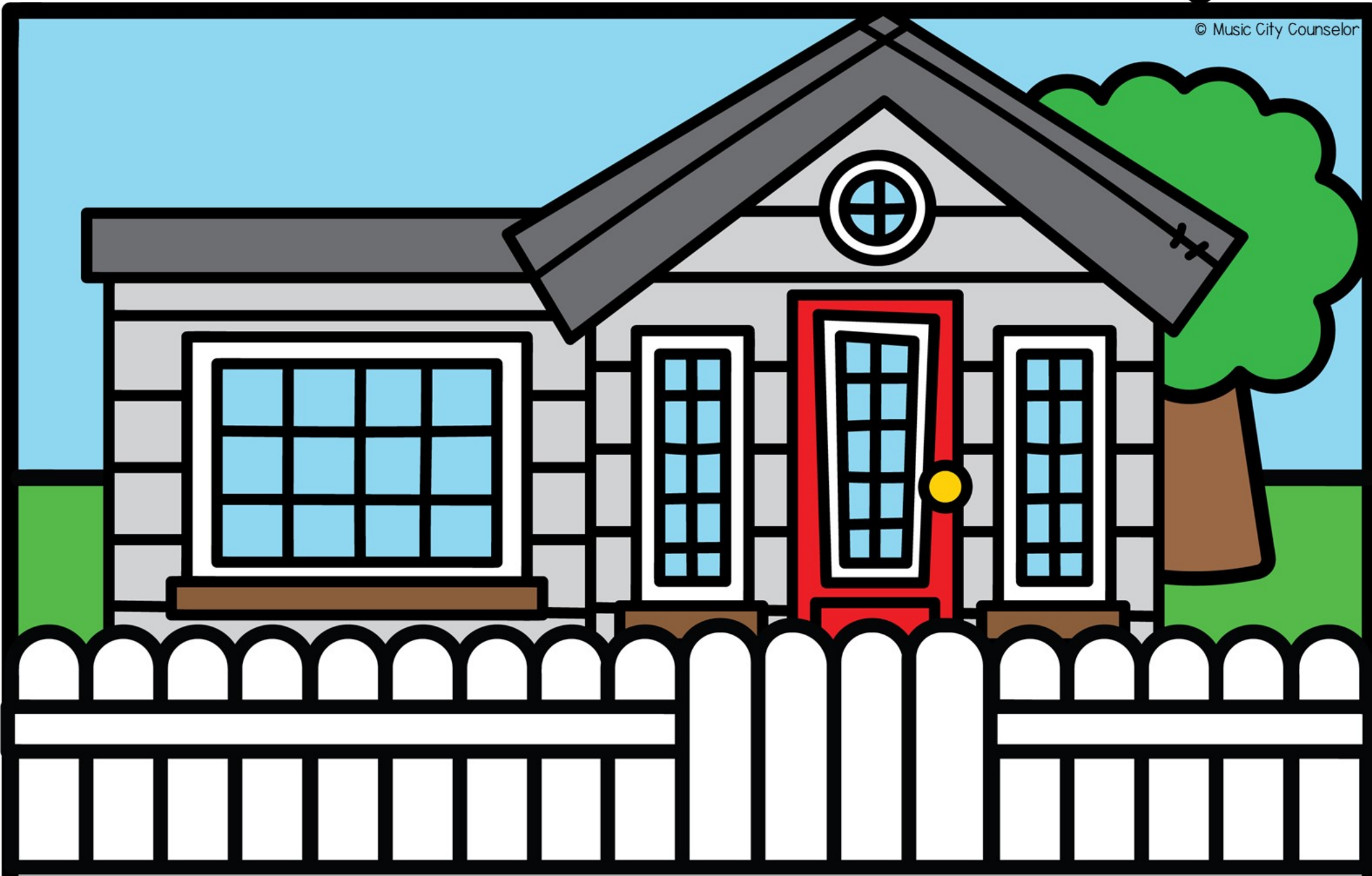
A black and white version of this activity is also included that students can decorate and take home. Students can color the houses and people and glue them where they belong.
