DIRECTIONS: TO PREPARE:

All of the materials are available to you in full color and black/white! Please be sure to only print the pages you need. I recommend printing all of the materials on cardstock and/or laminating them for durability and sturdiness. Please print the feelings poster, snowman feelings mat, snowman emojis, and scenario cards. Then, please cut out the snowman emojis and scenario cards.

TO PLAY:

This game can be played with individual students, small groups of students, a large classroom (on a projector), or in centers. To start, please review the "Snowman Feelings" poster with students and help them understand each of the 9 feeling words. To play the game, students take turns drawing a scenario card. The student reads the scenario card aloud (or the educator can read the card aloud for emerging readers). Then, the student imagines how they would feel in that situation and places the snowman emoji(s) that express their feelings on top of the snowman body to "build the snowman." If a student would experience more than one feeling in that scenario, they can first place one snowman emoji, then place another. The students and educator can talk through the scenario and feelings associated with it and relate the scenario back to the students' own lives. 32 scenario cards are included so you can play until the cards run out or as time allows. There are 4 blank cards in case you'd like to create your own.
