# How to Use the Digital Activity:

**IMPORTANT NOTE: PLEASE USE THIS ACTIVITY  
IN "EDIT MODE," NOT IN FULL-SCREEN  
"PRESENTATION MODE."**

1. This wants vs. needs sorting activity is a great resource to use with students after reading the story, "Those Shoes" by Maribeth Boelts and reviewing the PowerPoint. It teaches students the difference between wants and needs, then asks them to read scenarios and sort them as a "want" or a "need." If they believe the scenario shows a "want," they drag the red X to the "wants" box. If they believe the scenario shows a "need," they drag the red X to the "needs" box. At the end, students can type about what really matters in their life on the text box that says "Type here."
