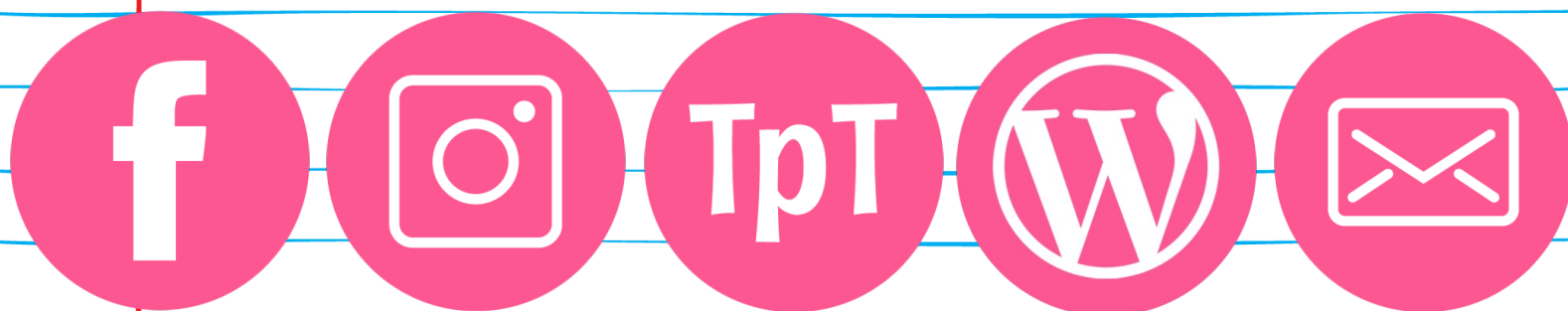

DIRECTIONS PAGE 1:

This lesson will take approximately 45 minutes to complete.

Materials Needed:

- Printed materials
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
- Pencils
- Glue sticks
- 1 piece of construction paper per child

Recommended Sequence:

1. Review the PowerPoint or digital for Google Slides™ presentation.
2. Review the instructional posters and display the bulletin board if you'd like.
3. Use the discussion cards with students.
4. Complete the craft, a worksheet, or a coloring page of your choice.
5. Students can decorate the mini story book and take it home to read with their families.

Presentation:

Both a PowerPoint and digital for Google Slides™ presentation are included.

This presentation teaches students all about **trustworthiness**. First, students "meet" Tanner, a little boy who everyone knows as "Trustworthy Tanner." Then, students learn the **definition of trustworthiness**. Next, students listen to a story about Tanner whose friend James trusts him to take care of his cat, Whiskers. Next, students "**turn and talk**" with a partner and discuss 2 reflection questions about the story. Then, students learn **7 ways to be trustworthy**. Finally, students "**turn and talk**" with a partner to reflect on how they can be more trustworthy in their lives.

Bulletin Board:

9 beautiful posters are included as well as printable letters that say BE TRUSTWORTHY. Please cut out the letters and staple them to the top of your bulletin board. Then, display the posters in any order that you'd like. Please see the sample on the next page.

DIRECTIONS PAGE 2:

Discussion Cards:

12 discussion cards are included. You may choose to use these as a whole group or divide students into small groups. I prefer to divide students into groups of 2-4 and give each group 2-3 cards. Students can discuss their thoughts with their small group then share out with the class.

Trustworthy Cat Craft:

Please give each student a printed cat, scissors, a glue stick, markers or crayons, a pencil, and a piece of construction paper. Please choose either the craft with the writing lines or the blank space. Students can write or draw what trustworthiness means to them. Then, they can cut out their cat and glue it onto a piece of construction paper.

Mini Story Book:

This is a half-page version of the "Tanner is Trustworthy" story from the presentation. Please print one story for each student, cut it down the middle, and staple it at the top. Students can color the story and take it home to read with their families.

Assorted worksheets and coloring pages are included. Please choose those that best fit the needs and abilities of your students, and the amount of time that you have.

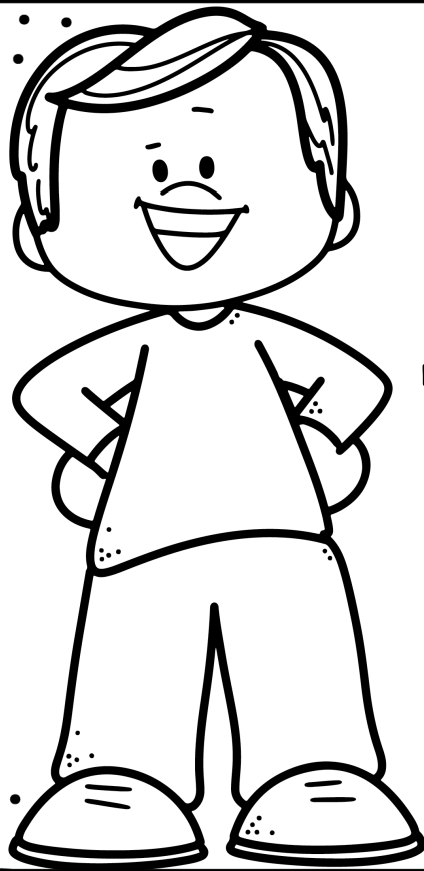


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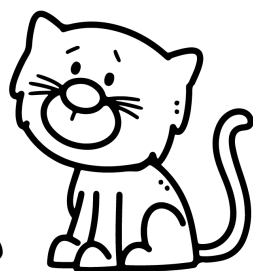

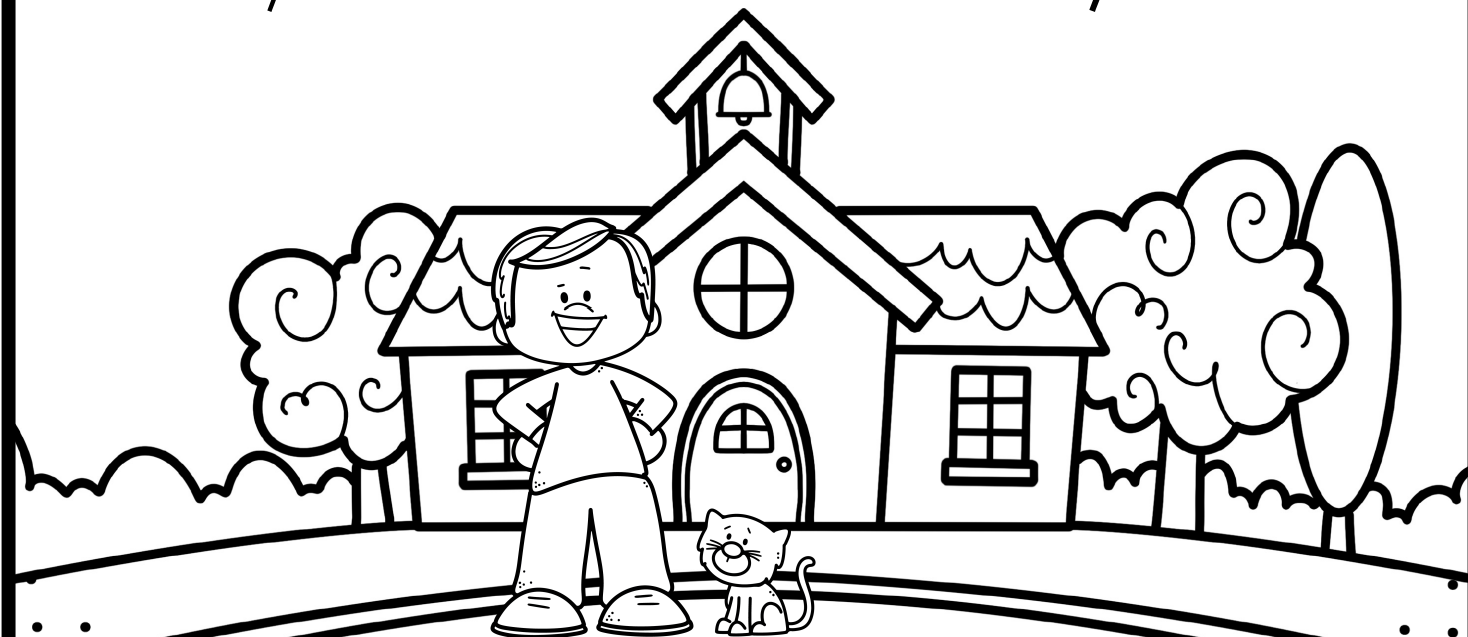


TANNER is TRUSTWORTHY



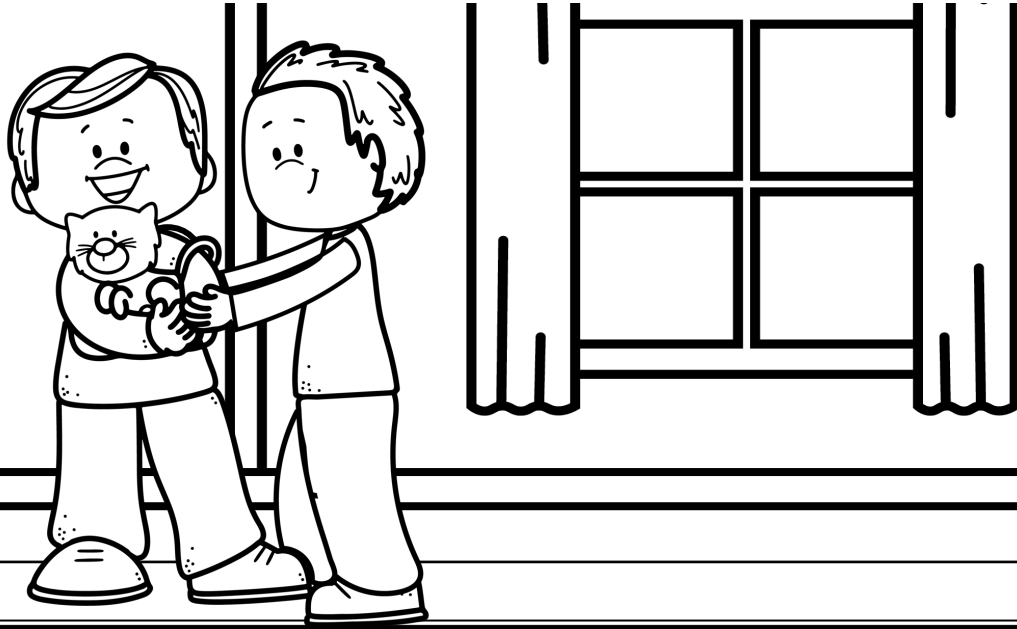
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• • Meet Tanner! He is a 2nd grader who loves cats, • •

Everyone knows him as Trustworthy Tanner!



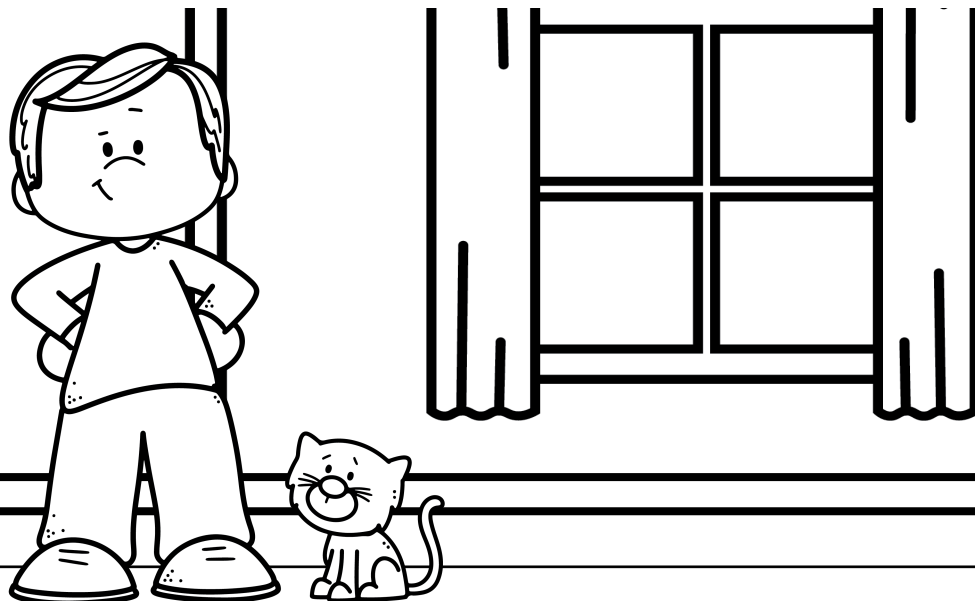
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: • One day, James asked his friend Tanner for a big favor. He needed to visit his grandma, but couldn't take his cat Whiskers along with him. • :



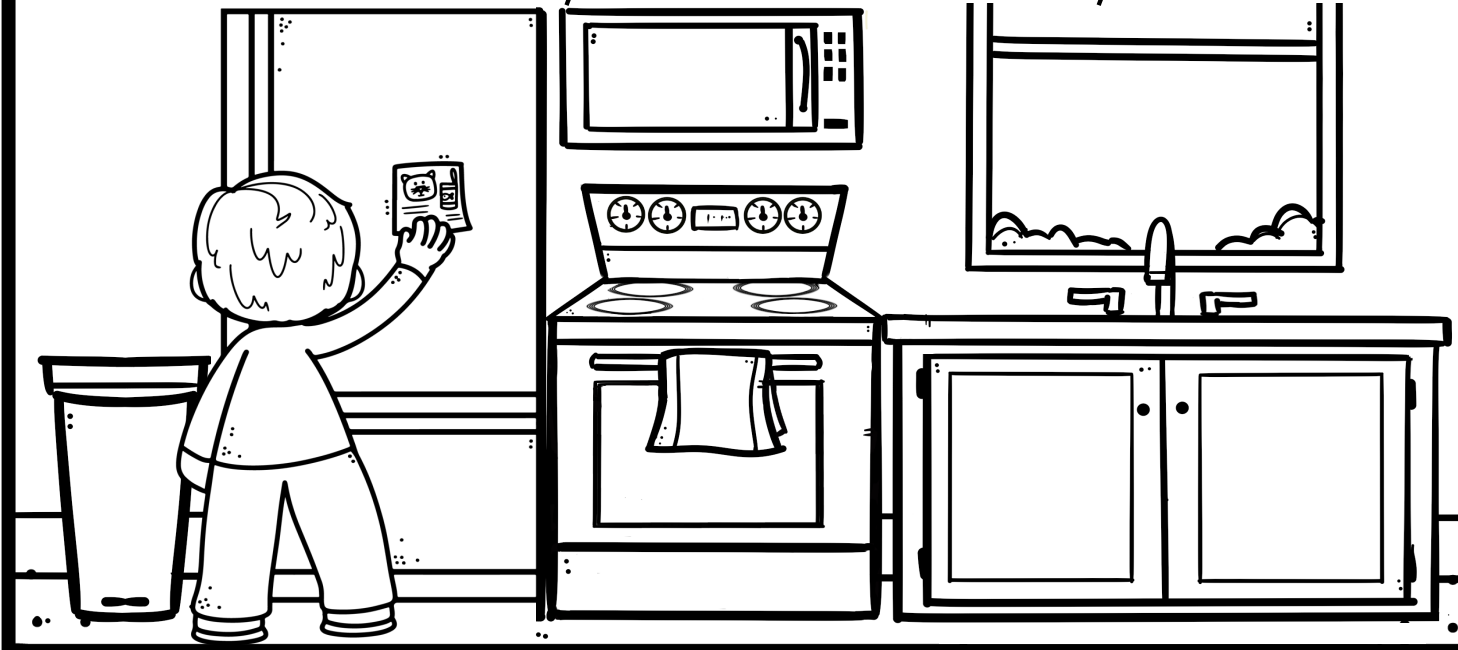
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: James asked if Tanner could take care of Whisker's for the day. Tanner, said, "Yes!" It was a big responsibility, but he was happy to help a friend. • :



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James wrote directions for how to take care of Whiskers and taped them to the fridge. Tanner read them carefully so he knew exactly what to do.



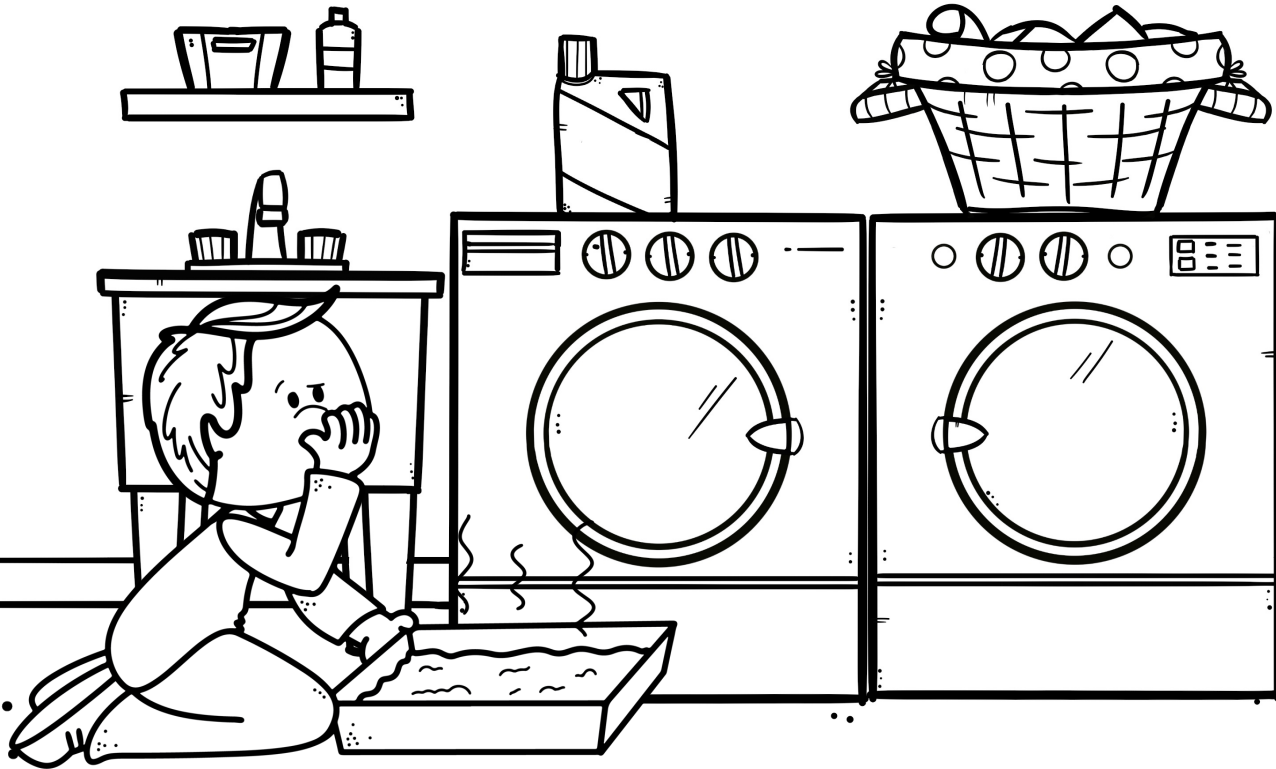
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First, Tanner fed Whiskers.



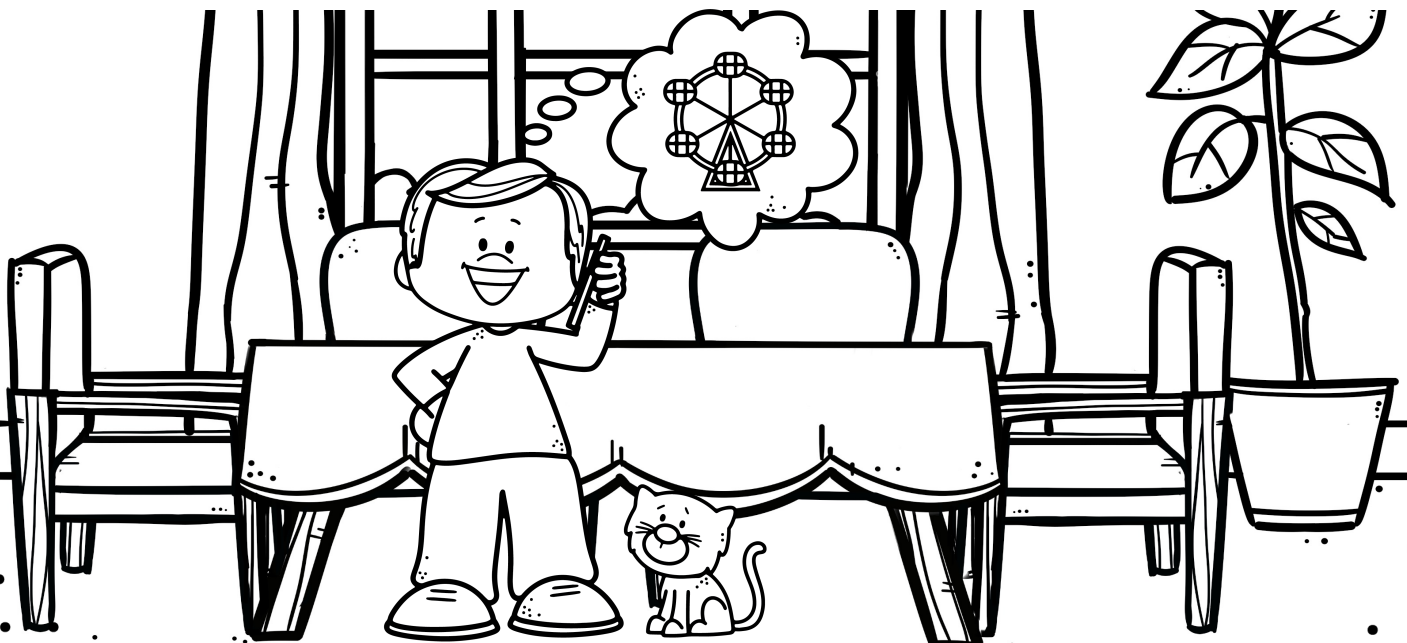
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Next, he cleaned Whiskers' litter box.



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Later on, Tanner's friend invited him to the fair. It sounded fun, but Tanner had a job to do. James trusted him to take care of Whiskers!



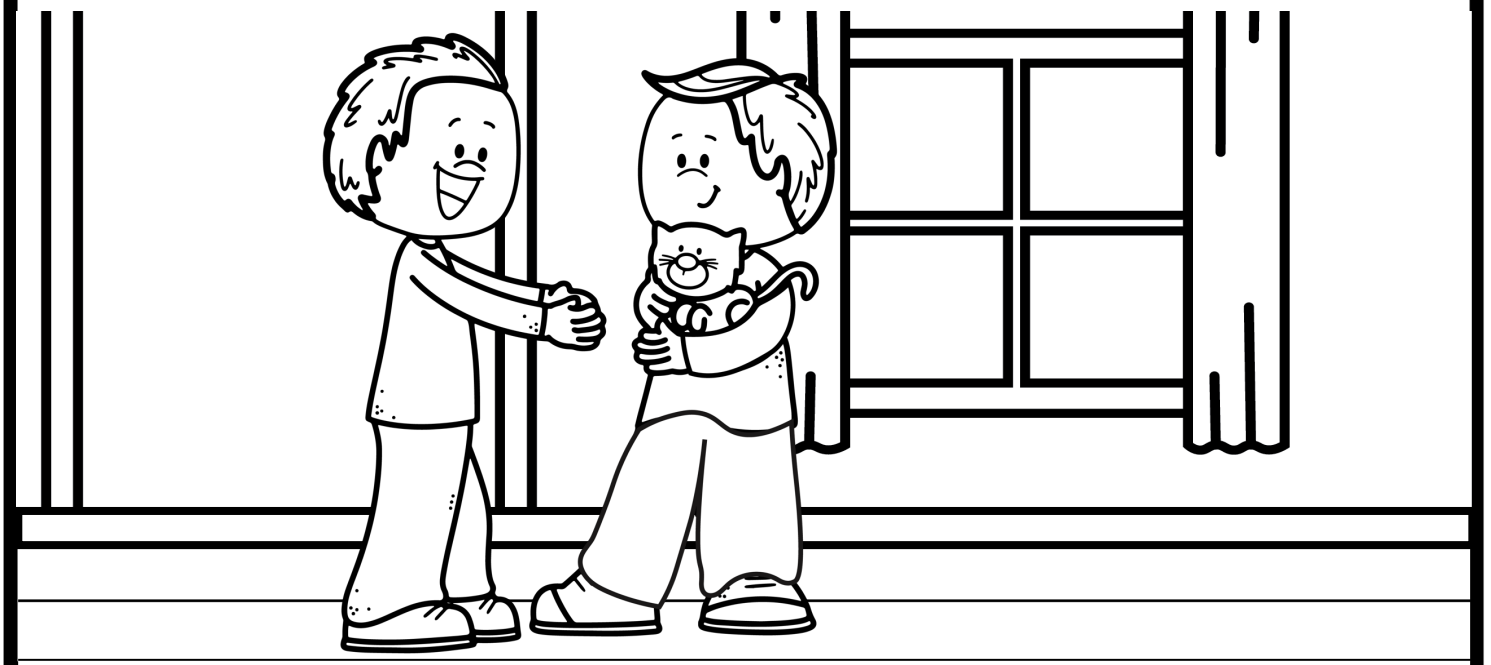
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• • Tanner stayed home and played with Whiskers. • •
