DIRECTIONS:

This lesson will take approximately 45 minutes to complete.

1. Review the PowerPoint or digital for Google Slides presentation with students.
2. Review the instructional posters.
3. Complete a craft, worksheet, or coloring page.
4. Give the certificate to students who have "All-Star Attendance."

Presentation:

This presentation tells the story of Juan, a boy who is late for school. His alarm clock doesn't go off, and he races around his house getting ready as fast as he can. When he makes it to school, his principal teaches him 8 ways to have "All-Star Attendance." The presentation closes with 3 discussion questions that let students reflect on the story and how to have All-Star Attendance.

Craft:

This craft includes 2 boy and 2 girl versions, as well as 2 types of writing lines. Please let students choose the clipart character that looks the most like them.

Please ask students to write on the lines the ways they can have All-Star Attendance. Then, they can color the kid with the star. Next, they can cut out the kid and glue it to the top of the writing page. A sample of the craft is provided on the next page. These make for a great hallway display!

Worksheets & Coloring Pages:

Assorted worksheets and coloring pages are included. Please choose those that best fit the needs and developmental level of your students, and the amount of time you have.

Star Student Certificate:

4 versions of an All-Star Attendance certificate are included. Please award students a certificate for showing excellent effort, progress, or growth with their attendance.
