DIRECTIONS:

RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE:

1. Review the PowerPoint or digital for Google Slides presentation.
2. Review the instructional posters (YES, My School Social Worker; NO, NOT My School Social Worker).
3. Complete the digital or printable sorting game.
4. Complete a coloring page or worksheet.

Please only print the pages that you need. Male and female versions of the posters, bag sorting game, and coloring pages are included.

Please choose the materials that best fit your gender. You may choose to print the full color or black/white version.

TO ASSEMBLE THE BAG SORTING GAME:

To assemble the bags, please grab two brown paper lunch sacks or gift bags of similar size. Please cut out the clipart social workers with the "YES My School Social Worker" and the "NOT My School Social Worker" labels attached to them. Please glue them onto the front of the bags (please see the sample provided!). Then, please print the scenario cards and cut them out individually.

PRESENTATION:

Please start the lesson by reviewing the PowerPoint or digital for Google Slides presentation with students. This presentation teaches students all about the role of the school social worker. The second slide is customizable to teach students all about you. Please add your photo to the frame by first deleting my sample, then going to Insert → Pictures → This Device → Choose your picture → Insert. Then, please write your name on the name tag. Finally, please write a description about you and or/your role on the clipboard.

Then, the presentation reviews the 10 words that describe the role of the school social worker. On the last slide, students can turn and talk with a neighbor about the ways a school social worker can help them.

INSTRUCTIONAL POSTERS:

Instructional posters are provided that review the role of the school social worker. Please review these with students and explain what a school social worker "is" and "is not." These are also great to display in your space!

TO PLAY THE BAG SORTING GAME:

Please place the two brown paper lunch sacks at the front of the classroom and hold onto the pile of scenario cards. I ask students to take turns choosing one of 34 scenario cards, reading it aloud to the class, and then placing it in the "YES My School Social Worker" bag if it does apply to the school social worker's role, or in the "NOT My School Social Worker" bag if it does NOT apply to the school social worker's role. These cards and scenarios can generate great discussion amongst students. Feel free to expand on them and help students understand more about your specific role at your school, too!

WORKSHEETS & COLORING PAGES:

Assorted worksheets and coloring pages are included that you can use to close the lesson and/or send home with students. These are also great to have available at Open House or Back to School Night to teach your school community about your role!
