Careers at the FIRE STATION



Firefighter

Firefighters extinguish and control fires to protect people and property. They conduct rescue efforts to save people from burning buildings and accident scenes. They administer first aid to those injured.

Workplace: Fire Dept., Various Locations

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Understanding/awareness of others behaviors, able to use logic & reason, problem solving skills, stress tolerance, coordination, monitoring equipment, steadiness of hand/arm, quick reaction time.

Careers at the DENTIST OFFICE



Dentist

Dentists treat problems with teeth, gums, and other parts of the mouth. They provide information to their patients about proper caring of teeth and gums to maintain good oral health.

Workplace: Dentist Office

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Patience, detail oriented, communication skills, ease in using hands, problem solving skills, leadership skills, organization skills, working with people.

Teacher

Teachers teach students academic, social, and other life skills. They help students one on one and in groups, using various teaching methods to meet all student's needs. They create lesson plans and learning goals.

Principal

Principals plan and supervise the workings of a school. They enforce discipline rules. They work with staff and parents to resolve issues. They examine teaching methods and curriculum.

School Counselor

School Counselors help students one on one or in groups. They help them understand and cope with personal, social or behavioral problems. They work with parents and teachers to discuss student progress.

Reporter

Reporters collect, analyze and report facts about newsworthy events. They report and write stories for newspapers, magazines, radio and TV. They investigate, research and interview people for stories.

Workplace: Newspaper, Website, TV or Radio Station.

Veterinarian

Veterinarians help animals who are sick from an injury or disease. They check animals to provide proper care by providing medicines or performing surgeries.

Workplace: Vet clinic

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Patience, communication skills, uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, concern/care for animals, integrity, attention to detail, stress tolerance.

Careers at the POLICE STATION



Police Officer

Police Officers enforce laws, prevent crime, regulate traffic, crowd control, and arrest criminals. They respond to emergencies and protect people and property. Document incidents and prepare reports.

Workplace: Police Dept., vehicle, and community.

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Understanding/awareness of others behaviors, conflict resolution skills, able to understand spoken information and directions, uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, stress tolerance, integrity.

Detective

Detectives gather facts and collect evidence of possible crimes. They conduct interviews, look at records, watch the activities of suspects and participate in arrests.

Workplace: Police Dept., Private office

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Integrity, self-control, stress tolerance, attention to detail, reasoning and problem-solving skills, good listening skills, good at speaking and reading.

Pharmacist

Pharmacists give medicines and information to patients. They work with Doctors and patients on the amount, type, and side effects of medicines.

Workplace: Pharmacy

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Detail oriented, communication skills, organization skills, instructing others, good at reading, speaking and writing, good listening skills, critical thinking skills.

Psychologist

Psychologists help understand how and why a person thinks, feels, and acts. They provide treatment through therapy for various disorders by helping clients set and work towards goals.

Workplace: Office, Hospital, School, Clinic

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Awareness and understanding of others behaviors, good listening skills, Reasoning and problem-solving skills, communication skills, providing care to others, sensitivity and empathy.

Social Worker

Social workers help improve the social and psychological well-being of children and their families. They may arrange adoptions, find foster homes, and provide resources.

Workplace: School, Office, Hospital, Homes, Clinics

Education: College Degree

Skills: Good listening skills, adaptability, communicate clearly, empathy, patience and self-control, understand others reactions and behaviors, stress tolerance, concern for others.

Singer

Singers perform songs on stage, radio, television or in movies. They memorize the music and routines. They perform in front of live audiences as a solo artist or part of a signing group.

Workplace: Stage, Studio

Education: No formal education needed.

Architect

Architects plan and design structures such as homes, offices, theaters, and factories. They prepare drawings and designs. They plan materials, estimated cost and equipment.

Accountant


Accountants study financial information and prepare reports to determine profit/loss, taxes, and problems. They keep track of records and prepare tax returns using accounting computer systems.

Author

Authors create written works that are original. Such as books, scripts, poetry, essays or journals. They edit written material to meet the needs of publishers.

Workplace: Homes, Offices

Education: College Degree

Skills: Creative thinking, good at writing and expressing in writing, originality, persistence, like to take on a challenge, innovative, good at reading, honesty.

Editor

Plan, coordinate, revise, or edit written material. Review proposals and drafts for possible publications in newspapers, books, scripts, journals, magazines, and websites.

Workplace: Homes, Offices.

Education: College Degree

Skills: Good at reading comprehension, writing, and speaking. Able to think critically, use active listening, and express yourself through writing. Strong grammatical skills.

Lawyer

Lawyers represent clients in criminal and civil legal proceedings. They create legal documents and analyze the likely outcome of cases using their knowledge of legal precedents.

Workplace: Courthouse, Law Office

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Decision making skills, oral expression, good writing, reading, and speaking, problem solving skills, integrity, stress tolerance, resolving conflicts and negotiating.

Judge

Judges ensure justice in a court of law. They follow government laws and rules. They instruct juries on laws, and rule on court decisions based on evidence and testimony.

Workplace: Courthouse

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Decision making skills, oral expression, good writing and speaking, good listening skills, uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, integrity, leadership, attention to detail.

Chef

Chefs are in charge of preparing, seasoning, and cooking foods from a menu. They plan and price menu items, order supplies and check food safety. They often supervise others.

Workplace: Restaurant

Education: Technical Training

Skills: Stress tolerance, sense of taste and smell, adaptability, oral comprehension, attention to detail, time management skills, management of others, understanding others reactions and behaviors.

Waiter/Waitress

Waiters take food and drink orders and serve them to customers. They suggest items on the menu and offer recommendations. They check to make sure customer is happy.

Workplace: Restaurant

Education: No formal education required.

Skills: Ability to multitask, communicative clearly, strong memory, patience and self-control, stress tolerance, steadiness of hand/arm, able to stand for long periods of time.

Careers at the AIRPORT



Flight Attendant

Flight attendants provide personal services on airlines to ensure the safety, security and comfort of passengers. They explain safety equipment's, serve food/drinks, verify tickets and administer first aid.

Workplace: Airplane, Airport

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Stress tolerance, adaptability, concern for others, good listening skills, communicate clearly, understanding others reactions, self-control, coordination

Pilot

Pilots navigate and fly planes to transport people and goods. They usually work with a team. They follow the rules of flying and check the planes instruments to keep them safe.

Workplace: Airport, Planes

Education: College Degree

Skills: Monitoring operations, know where objects are in relation to you, ability to know judge the distance of you and objects, decision making skills, good listening skills, problem solving skills, uses logic and reason.

Software Developer

Software Developers create computer programs, develop applications and systems that run a device. They design, develop, and test software.

Workplace: Office

Education: College Degree

Skills: Creative thinking, decision making, using computer and computer systems, oral and written comprehension, good listening skills, reasoning, critical, and problem-solving skills.

Web Developer

Web developers design, create and modify web sites. They find the needs of users to edit website content, graphics, and performance.

Workplace: Office

Education: Technical Training

Skills: Critical thinking, putting information or things in order, uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, analyzing needs, initiative, attention to detail, computer skills.

Careers at the HOSPITAL



Nurse

Nurses provide care to patients. They give medicine and treatment, and also work with Doctors. They provide support and advice to patients and their families.

Workplace: Hospital, Office, Homes, School

Education: College Degree

Skills: Good listening skills, ability to multitask, communicate clearly, reasoning and problem-solving skills, understand others reactions and behaviors, stress tolerance, concern/care for others.

Doctor

Doctors help their patients who are sick or injured and treat them using medicines. They teach their patients to be healthy and keep track of their health through tests.

Workplace: Hospital, Doctor's Office

Education: Graduate Degree

Skills: Good listening skills, communicate clearly, uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, good judgement, concern/care for others, integrity and dependability, attention to detail, self-control.

Financial Manager

Financial Managers determine how a company will spend, save and increase their money using data and creating goals. They create and maintain relationships with customers and provide help.

Workplace: Banks, Offices

Bank Teller

Receive and pay out money. Keep records of money involved in a financial institution's various transactions.

Retail Salesperson

General Manager

General Managers plan, direct and coordinate the operations of organizations. They create policies, review sales/financial reports, hire/fire staff, prepare schedules and assign duties.

Workplace: Store, Office

Education: College Degree

Skills: Monitoring of others performance, likes a challenge, dependability, leadership, oral and written comprehension, good listening skills, problem solving skills.

Careers at the **LABORATORY**



Genetic Counselor

Genetic Counselors help individuals or families to determine the risk for genetic diseases and inherited conditions. They interpret lab results and explain findings.

Workplace: Lab, Office

Education: College Degree

Skills: Communicate clearly, patience, self-control, understand others reactions and behaviors, concern for others, problem solving skills. good at reading, writing, and speaking, attention to detail.

Microbiologist

Microbiologists study bacteria, viruses, algae, and fungi. They try to understand how these tiny organism's live and grow. They do this to better understand disease's and how to cure them.

Workplace: Laboratory

Education: College Degree

Skills: Interest in Science, Biology and Chemistry, attention to detail, good at reading and writing, logical thinking, likes to take on a challenge, reliable, responsible.

Robotic Engineer

Robotics Engineers design and create robots and robotic systems that are able to perform duties that humans are either unable or prefer not to complete.

Workplace: Office, Lab, Factory

Education: College Degree

Skills: Uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, good at Reading, good listening skills, good judgement, persistence, attention to detail, ability to imagine how something will look.

Factory Worker

Operate or tend machines to prepare industrial or consumer products for storage or shipment.

Workplace: Factory, Warehouse

Construction Worker

Construction workers perform physical labor to assist in the building of sites. They use tools and operate machinery. They read building plans, load/unload building materials, clean and prepare sites.

Workplace: Construction sites

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Hand/arm coordination, strength (lift, push, pull, carry), good listening skills, good at Reading, monitoring equipment, skills and ease of using arms/hands, quick reaction time.

Carpenter


Carpenters create and repair things using wood, tools, and machinery. They prepare projects by studying sketches, measuring, cutting, and installing items.

Workplace: Various (indoor/outdoor)

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Hand/arm coordination, self-monitoring, arranging things/actions in a certain order or pattern, visualizing how something will look, strength, good listening skills, problem solving skills.

Careers at the SPACE STATION



Aerospace Engineer

Aerospace engineers design, construct, and test aircraft, missiles and space craft. They also research materials and equipment to design aircraft.

Workplace: Office, Factory

Education: College Degree

Skills: Use logic and reason, problem solving skills, good at reading and writing, good listening skills, use scientific rules and methods to solve problems, analyzing data and information, able to find patterns.

Astronaut

Astronauts conduct experiments and gather information while in space flight. They also conduct experiments with the spacecraft itself to develop new concepts in design, engineering, and the navigation.

Workplace: Space station, space center training.

Education: College Degree

Skills: Integrity, self-control, stress tolerance, attention to detail, reasoning and problem-solving skills, leadership skills, exceptional communication skills, multi-tasking skills, good eyesight.

Careers at TOWN HALL



Legislator

Legislators develop, introduce, and enact laws and statutes at the local, tribal, state, or federal level. They are elected to this position by voters. They analyze and understand local and national legislation.

Workplace: Town Hall, Office

Education: College Degree

Skills: Decision making skills, oral expression, oral and written comprehension, good listening skills, uses logic and reasoning, problem solving skills, integrity, leadership.

Secretary

Secretaries complete clerical duties like scheduling appointments, answering phones, maintaining files, and doing other office duties.

Workplace: Town Hall, Office, School

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Good at reading, writing, and speaking, time Management skills, good listening skills, oral and Written expression, attention to detail, independence dependability.

Careers at HOMES



Plumber

Plumbers repair, install and put together pipes, fittings, and fixtures of heating, water, and drainage systems. They install appliances such as dishwashers, water heaters, toilets or sinks using tools.

Workplace: Varies (Homes, Businesses)

Education: High School Diploma

Skills: Good up-close vision, flexibility, ease of using fingers, decision making, good listening skills, uses logic and reason, problem solving skills, monitoring operations of a machine.

Careers at the **ATHLETIC CENTER**



Athlete

Athletes compete in athletic events and maintain fitness and skill in their sport. This includes regular training, nutrition and working with coaches.

Workplace: Athletic center, sports arena.

Education: No formal education required.

Skills: Strength, able to do physical activities for long periods, coordination, communication skills, decision making skills, good listening skills, persistence, self-control.

Fitness Trainer

Instruct or coach groups or individuals in exercise activities for personal fitness.

Demonstrate techniques and form, observe participants, and explain corrective measures necessary to improve their skills.

Workplace: Athletic Center, gyms.

Education: Technical Training.

Skills: Body coordination, stamina, flexibility, service orientation, active listening, oral expression, good at instructing and helping others, an understanding of human behavior, able to provide feedback.

Curator

Plan and organize the acquisition, storage, and exhibition collections, such as artwork, collectibles, historic items, or scientific specimens of museums or other institutions.

Workplace: Museum, Galleries, historical sites.

Education: Graduate degree.

Skills: Identifying information by categorizing, creative thinking, organizing, planning, able to see details at close range, oral comprehension and expression, high integrity and initiative.

Careers at the UNIVERSITY



Anthropologist

Study the way of life, language, and physical characteristics of people in various parts of the world. Recover and examine bones, tools, and other artifacts remaining from past human cultures.

Workplace: University, Laboratories.

Education: Graduate degree.

Skills: Reading and writing comprehension, critical thinking, analyzing data and information, processing information, ability to combine information to come up with a conclusion.

Actor/Actress

Workplace: Radio station


