COMMUNITY HELPERS MATS

This activity was designed for PreK – Kindergartners to learn the tools that community helpers use. Both full color and black/white versions are included.

TO PREP THE ACTIVITY:

I recommend printing the materials on cardstock and/or laminating them for sturdiness. Please cut out each of the 6 community helper toppers. Please cut out each of the 6 community helper mats. Please cut out each of the 36 tools (cut along the rectangle edges). Please mix up the tools and place them in a small basket or container. Please glue the matching community helper topper to the top of each mat as shown in the sample. Hook-and-loop fastener dots allow students to easily attach/reattach the tools. Please place the rough side of a hook-and-loop fastener dot on the back of each tool. Please place the smooth side of a hook-and-loop fastener dot on each blank rectangle on the mats.

TO USE THE ACTIVITY:

This activity is perfect for centers, independent work, and small group work. The objective is to find the 6 tools that each community helper uses and place them on the blank squares on the corresponding mat. There are many ways to use this activity! My favorite is to give students one community helper mat and the container of tools. Then, I ask them to try to find all 6 tools that their helper uses and attach them to the blank spaces on the mat. Once they finish one community helper, they can move onto the next!

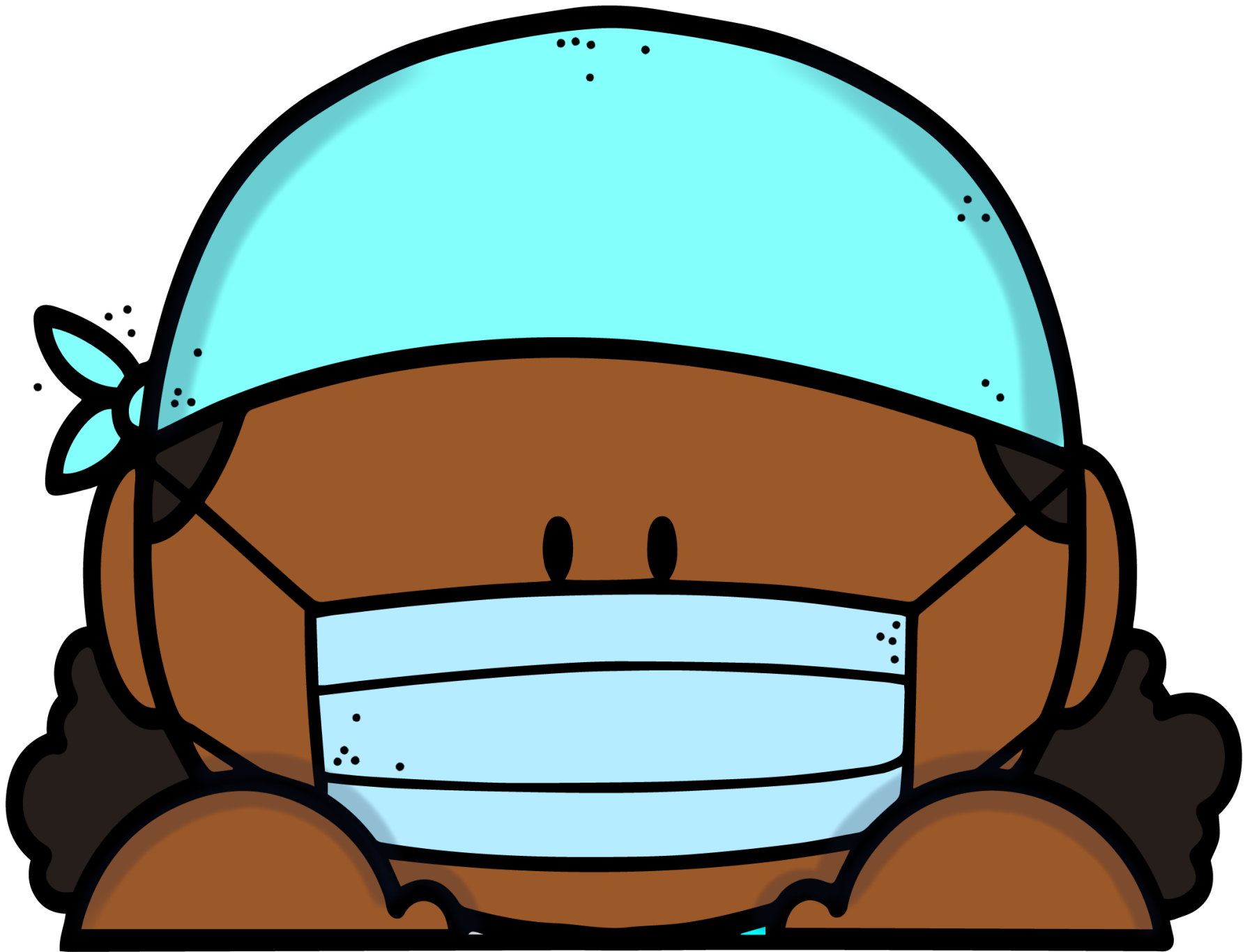
