General Google Slides Directions:

1. Please sign in with your Google account.
2. Please click "make a copy" and a copy of the lesson will automatically be saved to your Google Drive.
3. If you are using Google Classroom, please assign the activity as an assignment to your students.
4. If you are not using Google Classroom, you can post the resource to the virtual platform that you are using, or email the link directly to students. If you email the link to students, please make sure that they or their parents have a free Google account first. They will click on the link, sign in with their Google account, and then a copy of the lesson will automatically be saved to their Google Drive. They can then use any device (tablet, smart phone, computer) to access the resource.
5. To use the interactive features of the lesson, please make sure that you are in "edit mode," not in "presentation" full-screen mode.

How to Use the Activity:

****Please make sure students are using the presentation in "edit" mode (NOT in full-screen "presentation" mode) or the interactive slides will not work!****

- This presentation teaches students the difference between bullying and conflict. Students learn the definition of bullying, the definition of conflict, and examples of each one. They learn how bullying and conflict are different. They also learn what to do if they are bullied or if they are experiencing a conflict with a friend.
- The presentation includes 2 slides of discussion questions for students. They can type directly in the text boxes that say, "type here."
- Finally, the presentation offers 24 scenarios for students to practice deciding if they show bullying or conflict. Directions are included. Students read the scenario, then move the blue checkmark to the circle on the "bullying" side if the scenario shows bullying, or to the circle on the "conflict" side if the scenario shows conflict.
- Printable activities are also included in the zip folder that you can use to supplement or close the lesson if you'd like!
